The first quarter of this year has been incredibly busy! During these several weeks, we prepared for and hosted a team of 54 Chi Alpha students and staff from Indiana University. We led them on an exposure trip through the three Baltic countries, visiting five cities: Vilnius, Kaunas, Riga, Tartu, and Tallinn. God has sovereignly united our hearts with the Great Lakes Chi Alpha. These students were challenged by their leaders, "to give a year and pray about a lifetime" in missions all through the fall semester. They were further challenged at The World Missions Summit we attended in January in a powerful way. Throughout the trip, students repeatedly said things like, "I am definitely coming back here!" or, "God has called me to the Baltics!" Imagine what would happen if we had a team of student leaders move to each of the cities we visited and launched a Chi Alpha? **God is doing something!**



In February, Kandra and I traveled through the Baltics meeting with national church leaders to explain our new role as Geographical Leaders and discuss our common goals going forward. We have many of the same ideas, in terms of church planting and a commitment to make disciples of the Baltic peoples. **Again, God is doing something!**

Our annual missionary conference and leadership meetings in Spain just concluded at the end of March. It was a wonderful time to reconnect with our missionary family, get to know the new people that have come to the area in the past year, and most importantly to hear from God. For 11 months we have sent out a bi-weekly prayer email to people that have expressed a specific interest in prayer. The enemy is not going to like it when we invade the campuses with the gospel!"

We need you to join us each week for a one-hour time of prayer. You will be able to join online on a video conference or call in and pray over the phone. This will be a guided time of laser-focused prayer for the ministry in the Baltics. This is not just for our ministry, but for all of the missionaries and ministries that they lead as well. We will join the prayer time as well from overseas when possible (most of the time).
